 - Provide a short personal statement describing how your attributes might best be applied to the ideals of these awards.
 - List all previous bursaries, scholarships and/or awards (if any) received while at university.
 - What sort of career or work do you anticipate following after completion of your degree?
 - State what has motivated you to be involved in student affairs/organisations at UCT.
 - What are your leisure interests, sports and hobbies?
 - Is there any other information you think may affect this application?
